PARKING & DIRECTIONS

Located off Interstate Loop 610 between Kirby and Fannin, Reliant Park is Houston's top exhibition venue, composed of several state-of-the-art facilities -- Reliant Stadium, Reliant Astrodome, Reliant Arena and Reliant Center.

Reliant Center, site of the Reliant Park World Series of Dog Shows, is a 700,000 square-foot exhibition and meeting hall and the campus' northernmost building. Parking is only available in the North Fannin Lot (Orange), which you can reach from Fannin via the Holly Hall entrance or from Main at the McNee entrance to avoid South Loop construction. The parking fee is \$8 per day. You may also reach Reliant Center by MetroRail at the Holly Hall stop.

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Rules Applying to Dog Shows

Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Attention Reliant Park World Series of Dog Shows Exhibitors

Preferred Grooming Space: In order to provide better comfort and protection for you and your dogs, the Reliant World Series of Dog Shows will continue to offer preferred crating and grooming space. This will allow you to unload dogs at your leisure, when the building is fully air-conditioned. For exhibitors who do not show until Friday, you can save on hotel bills, and still be assured of having a space. Reservations close July 1, 2009.

Site Availability:

1. Exhibitors with reservations can unload equipment only into the building from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm on Tuesday, July 14, 2009. All vehicles must be removed by 6:00 pm. No dogs will be allowed in the building overnight on Tuesday.
2. Exhibitors with and without grooming space reservations can drive in to unload no earlier than 6:00 am on Wednesday, July 15. All vehicles must be removed by 1:00 pm on Wednesday, July 15. Drive-in will not be allowed after 12:30 pm.
3. Numbers will be issued to exhibitors without grooming space reservations. Admission will occur in numerical sequence whether entering by foot or by vehicle.
4. All engines and generators must be turned off during unloading and loading.
5. Exhibitors are required to unload and remove their vehicles as quickly as possible. You can setup your equipment after your vehicle is removed.
6. All dogs and equipment must be removed immediately following BIS on Sunday, July 19, 2009.
7. The building is fully air conditioned, except during hours of vehicle access. Please plan accordingly.

Access & Parking:

1. All vehicle access to the building will be through the ramps at the north loading docks. These ramps are only accessible from North Stadium Dr, Entrance 12 on the map.
2. During the show, all exhibitors are encouraged to enter the property through entrances 10, 11 or 12. After load-in on Wednesday, only vehicles with in/out passes will be permitted through North Stadium Drive, Entrance 12.
3. Conformation exhibitor parking for vans, cars and motorhomes will be reserved in the North Kirby lot (Red Lot) adjacent to the building.
4. Obedience parking will be in the Tan lot behind the loading docks.
5. Conformation exhibitors arriving after drive-in parking can proceed to the North Kirby exhibitor lot and unload through the West entry doors.

6. Obedience exhibitors can proceed to the North loading dock and unload.
7. No hook-ups will be provided for recreational vehicles.
8. We have space for a limited number of motor homes to park in the Tan Lot immediately behind Hall E, exhibitor grooming area. All vehicles must be parked in an orderly manner to facilitate entering & leaving the lot. An overnight parking permit must be displayed.

Exhibitor Access Thursday through Sunday: All exhibitors must present proof of entry for building access during show hours Thursday through Sunday. Exhibitors who may not receive entries in the mail can check the "will call" box on their entries. These entries will be held by the superintendent for pickup in either San Antonio or Houston. Entry by people who are clearly exhibitors from the West exhibitor entrance or the North Loading docks before show hours will be waived through. Proof of entry or a hand stamp will be required to re-enter the building during show hours. Anyone entering through the Main Foyer will be required to have proof of admission.

BAER TESTING

BAER testing can be done on canines at least 35 days old. The hearing test is known as the brainstem auditory evoked response (BAER) or brainstem auditory evoked potential (BAEP) detects electrical activity in the cochle & auditory pathways in the brain. **Bilateral hearing passes the test. Unilateral or bilateral deafness fails.**

HEART SCREENING

CARDIAC AUSCULTATION should be done with the animal standing & restrained, but sedative drugs should be avoided. Panting must be controlled & if necessary, the dog should be given time to rest & acclimate to the environment. The veterinarian should be able to identify the cardiac valve areas for auscultation. The examiner should gradually move the stethoscope across all valve areas & also should auscultate over the subaortic area, ascending aorta, pulmonary artery & the left craniodorsal cardiac base. Following examination of the left precordium, the right precordium should be examined.

PATELLAS

Patellar luxation is caused by congenital abnormality usually at the level of the hip joint & results in abnormal forces on the kneecap, which cause it to eventually ride outside of the groove. The groove becomes very shallow & the attachment of the ligament of the patella may be malpositioned on the tibia bone. If the patellar luxation occurs in mature animals, the tibia & femur bones become twisted.
